Property Description

Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, Missouri, Inc., is cleaning up lead-contaminated property where it plans to build 10 new homes. The project will remove metals from the soil, most likely on the site due to runoff from an adjacent rail corridor. Due to the potential for future runoff, some site drainage correction will be a key component of the cleanup.

Missouri Brownfields Revolving Loan Funding

EIERA awarded a subgrant to Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, Missouri, Inc., for up to \$85,000. The Missouri Brownfields Revolving Loan Fund was capitalized through a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The revolving loan fund supports cleanup activities for sites contaminated with petroleum, hazardous or controlled substances and mine-scarred lands.
